**HUNTSVILLE – The 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Moon Over Three Caves Dance, scheduled for Saturday, September 20, from 7:30 to 11 pm, will benefit the land preservation work of The Land Trust of Huntsville & North Alabama. The event site is Historic Three Caves Quarry at the foot of Monte Sano Mountain in Huntsville. Presenting Sponsors are Solid Earth, Inc. and Servis1st.**

Three Caves is a former limestone quarry that's fast becoming a natural cave.
