## **Oakwood University Hosts Camp Meeting Featuring Life-Sized Sanctuary Model**

**Huntsville, Ala.** — Oakwood University will host the 63rd Annual Camp Meeting of the South Central Conference of Seventh-day Adventists on its campus, June 5-13. The theme for the week is “The Temple of God.” Each summer, Camp Meeting provides numerous worship services, workshops, Bible Bowl and physical fitness competitions, Pathfinder and Youth Ministry parades, and spiritually enriching activities for all ages.

What’s unique this year is a full-scale model of the Old Testament sanctuary that will be constructed on the Oakwood’s campus, located at 7000 Adventist Boulevard in Huntsville, and will be open to the public for tours. “Messiah’s Mansion,” as the display is called, is a replica of the Mosaic sanctuary—the size you might have seen if you had been alive in the days of Moses! Imagine the impact of walking through this realistic scale-constructed sanctuary model with family members and friends as biblical concepts come to life before your eyes. What’s more, it’s free!

Daily tours will be available from 9:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m., with the last tour of the day beginning at 6:00 p.m. Tour guides will facilitate a new group every 15 minutes, with each tour lasting approximately an hour and 15 minutes.
